The traditional Craft Show this year will take place on the first Sunday in June and is the start of Washington Week -- a celebration of the beginning of summer. In addition to the crafters and exhibitors at the show, the Washington Historical Society invites local non-profit organizations to exhibit with no fee for their space.

The Show is the principal fund raiser for the Greater Washington Area Historical Society, a non-profit 501(c)3 organization. All of the people who assist at the show are volunteers. The Museum is open for tours on that day and no admission is charged. Current exhibits include a music room, a Victorian bedroom, a 1930s kitchen, a war room, an extensive Boy Scout collection, a George Washington display, and information about the history of the Washington area and families that have lived here.
